


ALICE is your child care worker, the cashier at your supermarket, the gas attendant, the salesperson at your big box store, your waitress, a home health aide, an office clerk.




ALICE cannot always pay the bills, has little or nothing in savings, and is forced to make tough choices such as deciding between quality child care or paying the rent.



The Media and ALICE ALICE? Why should we care?


1.3 million hard-working Pennsylvania households have incomes which exceed the federal poverty level, but are not high enough to pay for their basic needs.

When you add in households that live below the federal poverty level, that's 2 million, or 39% of PA households who are struggling to survive.



Client/individual who is ALICE to tell their story





Visuals:


- Video/photos of ALICE at work, with family, in daily routine including natural sound
- Cut-away/reaction shots of interviewees
- (TV/Digital reports)
- Standup location (placing the reporter on scene)





The Media and ALICE Acing the Media Interview

- Choose your outfit wisely
- Think succinct sound bites and practice!
- Relaxed body language
- Take a breath, and slow down your speech
- Practice how you listen (cut-away shots)
- Think "conversation" rather than interview
