

## Calculating PA Child Care Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act Funding

**Step 1: All providers will receive funds based on licensed capacity and provider type.**

Provider Type	\$ per provider
School-Age Only	\$2,700
Family Child Care Homes	\$1,700
Group Child Care Homes	\$2,000
Category 1 Child Care Centers (licensed capacity of 8 -38)	\$2,300
Category 2 Child Care Centers (licensed capacity of 39-61)	\$4,100
Category 3 Child Care Centers (licensed capacity of 62-92)	\$6,500
Category 4 Child Care Centers (licensed capacity of 93-137)	\$9,700
Category 5 Child Care Centers (licensed capacity of 138-596)	\$16,500

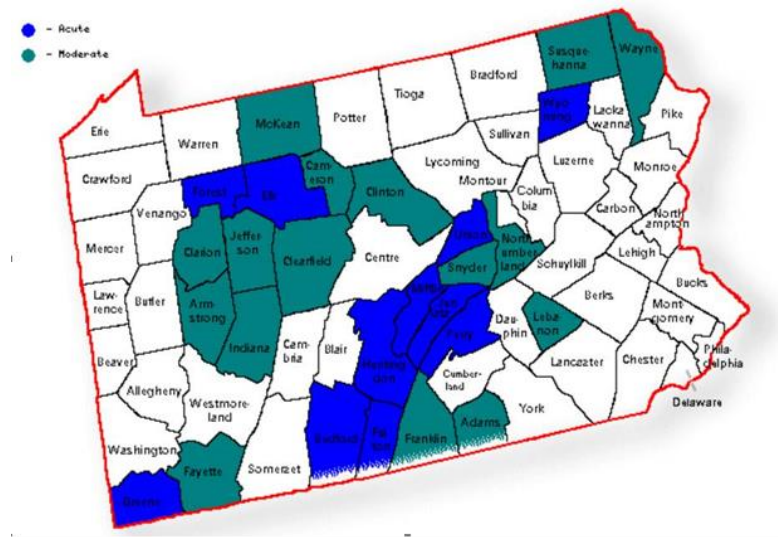
**Step 2: Participating providers will receive an add-on for Child Care Works (CCW) enrollment.**

Each eligible provider is allocated \$100 per active CCW enrollment as of March 13, 2020.

**Step 3: Some providers will receive an add-on for operating in a county with limited child care capacity.**

Category	Moderate	Acute
Family Child Care Homes	\$1,000	\$1,500
Group Child Care Homes	\$2,000	\$3,000
Category 1 Child Care Centers (licensed capacity of 12-41)	\$6,000	\$6,700
Category 2 Child Care Centers (licensed capacity of 42-74)	\$11,900	\$14,100
Category 3 Child Care Centers (licensed capacity of 75-196)	\$22,200	\$28,400

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## Step 4: Estimated Payment

**Amount Step 1 + Amount Step 2 + Amount Step 3 = Estimated Payment**
