

Training Standards

- All sessions are co-facilitated.
- All trainers have been trained in trauma information, group dynamics and emotionally healthy leadership principles.
- All trainers have been mentored and apprenticed with another mentor trainer.
- Lakeside trainers all participate in on-going assessment, evaluation and professional development for their own growth.

Training Model
